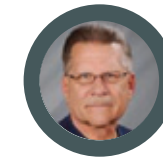

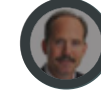
★ If elected, would you support including business policies, such as providing domestic partner/marriage benefits to LGBT employees, as a positive criteria in the bidding process for city contracts?
